New risk management tool in testing at CTCs

This summer, we're at CTC to test a new risk management tool designed by the Risk Matrix working group. This tool is meant to help staff quickly identify and assess risks, and communicate more effectively about them

across the organization. Risks include not just physical dangers, but also things which would affect the emotional or social well-being of cadets and staff, or the reputation of the organization. The easy-to-use tool will enable leaders at all levels to streamline the risk assessment process, make solid decisions about activities, and communicate about risk with staff, cadets, and parents. Over the last few months, the Junior Canadian Ranger Program Costing working group has been reviewing the costs of the program. They found that most funding already goes to community-level training and support, and suggested some ideas for other investments to improve the JCR program experience:

Establishing 14 new patrols

Creating additional support resources

Youth-focused training and professional development for adult staff and volunteers

More outdoor clothing and equipment for JCRs

International training opportunities

Exchanges between patrols from different Canadian Ranger **Patrol Groups**

What's this Group Order thing, anyway?

Natl CJCR Sp Gp Orders are a more intuitive, user-friendly directive, designed to gradually replace Cadet Administrative and Training Orders (CATOs). Group orders are based on a standard format used throughout the Canadian Armed Forces, and are meant to make it less complicated to find the information you're looking for. As well, the CCO extranet library has been reorganized to help make

it easier to find and access Group Orders, along with other documents like CANCDTGENs and OR (Cadets). Just click on the "Policy" tab at the top of the page to see them. Five new group orders are already available, and are in use by CTC staff this summer.
