CADET365

We have begun the process of transitioning all cadets to the new Cadet365 platform. As all cadets move to Cadet365, we will be retiring our @87eagle.ca system within the next few months. Please make sure to complete the transition ASAP.

What is happening:

All cadets and staff now have access to Cadet365, an online platform almost identical to the @87eagle.ca one we have been using for the past 2 years. This new platform replaces your @87eagle.ca Teams account with a @cdt.cadets.gc.ca account. The good news is that it still uses the same Teams and Outlook you are used to, so you should feel right at home.

Why is this happening:

The CJCR (Cadet and Junior Canadian Rangers) formation has adopted the Microsoft365 platform for all cadets and staff across the country, nicknamed Cadet365. Cadet365 will serve as the official communication platform for our Squadron and the organization, as well as be used for summer training and other training activities. It is **required** in order to attend CTCs this summer.

How do I get started:

Your account is now ready. We require that you perform the following actions:

- 1. Visit teams.microsoft.com and LOG OUT
- 2. Login with the username and password that was emailed to you, if you did not receive this email, reach out to 87air@cadets.gc.ca

- 3. Change your password to something secure that you can remember
- 4. If you have added Microsoft Teams and/or Microsoft Outlook apps to your phone/tablet, make sure to login to your new account there as well

Your username is now also your new Cadet365 email address.

What if I get stuck:

If you need assistance, reach out to 87air@cadets.gc.ca

What about files that I have on 87eagle.ca?

Download them now. All files will be deleted after we retire it in a few months.
