TAGGING

1. Tagging is a mandatory activity for all cadets and is the main fundraiser for our unit. Cadets stand in front of popular locations (such as Seaway Mall, Walmart, etc.) around Welland and hand out “tags” in exchange for a donation to our Squadron;
2. Cadets are expected to sign up for a minimum of 2 shifts, and are encouraged to sign up for more;
3. Tagging during the Thanksgiving holiday is split up between 4 shifts, as outlined below;

4. Senior cadets will do a presentation the week before tagging commences for all cadets; and,
5. Parents/Guardians: Please come in with your cadet as we will need you to drive them to their tagging location and pick them up 15 mins before the end of their shift to return to Tagging HQ.

Cadets:

1. If you have signed up for a tagging shift, it is important to be there;
2. You are to be in full uniform (C3). Reminder to be on your best behaviour while tagging; while wearing a uniform you are representing not only yourself and the cadet program, but also the Canadians that served and continue to serve our country. You might be surprised to learn the background of the person you are asking for donations from, the uniform might mean a lot to them. Keep in mind the public is watching you, and we want to continue to have reports of outstanding behaviour from our cadets. Be proud to wear your uniform, and be proud to be a Royal Canadian Air Cadet;
3. Eating and drinking while tagging is strictly prohibited unless on break, away from your post;
4. Cell phone use is strictly prohibited unless used for coordinating box pick up, ride, or in the case of an emergency; and,
5. SSC members and Officers will be circulating locations in case you need a new box or anything else.
