### TAGGING

Thank you to all the cadets that have signed up already for tagging. It is the single biggest fundraiser we run, and contributes a significant amount of capital to fund training, keeping the building running, and allowing us to do extra activities like visiting the Aviation Museum in Hamilton, weekend trips away from home, and more. Cadets must participate in a mandatory of 3 tagging shifts. Anyone that is unable to must speak with the CO.

#### **Dates:**

1. Wednesday (April 5): 1700–2100hrs;
2. Thursday (April 6): 1700–2100hrs;

3. Saturday (April 8): 0800–1200hrs; and,
4. Saturday (April 8): 1200–1600hrs.

**Dress:** [C3](#) with cadet parka (or personal coat). Optional gloves and cadet toque may be worn.

**Meeting location:** Office above Ye Olde Squire at the main entrance of Seaway Mall. We will have a Sr Cadet directing you upstairs.

### **Special Notes**

1. Come in when dropping off your cadet; parents are asked to drive their child to their tagging location as most locations are outside the mall grounds (ie. grocery stores); and,
2. All locations (outside of the mall) will have cadets in groups of 2 minimum, and all locations will have staff/volunteer supervision.

### **RANGE AND AVIATION EXERCISE**

The Range and Aviation Exercise is a mandatory training activity for ALL cadets. It is a Saturday to Sunday overnight activity focused on aviation and marksmanship activities. Any cadet that is unable to attend must speak with the CO.
